(G-5) BOARDS OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ENTER INTO JOINT POOLING AGREEMENTS WITH PUBLIC ENTITIES, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 43A, § 482B OF THE CODE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING CASUALTY AND PROPERTY INSURANCE OR, IN ACCORDANCE WITH OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW, SELF-INSURING CASUALTY AND PROPERTY RISKS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 265

(House Bill 1243)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages Tax -  
Harford County Revenue Distribution
