(House Bill 962)

AN ACT concerning

Day Care - Property Tax Credit

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "DAY CARE PROVIDER" MEANS A PERSON LICENSED OR-REGISTERED, REGISTERED, OR ACCREDITED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE WHO PROVIDES FAMILY OR GROUP CHILD CARE SERVICES ON A REGULAR BASIS.
- (B) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT AGAINST THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON ANY IMPROVEMENT OF REAL PROPERTY THAT-IS-USED-BY-A-bigensed-br-Registered-bay-care PROVIDER-TO-PROVIDE-FAMILY-OR-GROUP-CHILD-CARE-SERVICES: PROVIDED THAT:
