(A) EACH COUNTY SHALL DEVELOP, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PLANNING, A NEEDS ASSESSMENT AND RECOMMENDATIONS A PLAN FOR DELIVERING FOR THE DELIVERY OF BEFORE- AND AFTER-SCHOOL CHILD CARE SERVICES TO CHILDREN WHO ARE AT LEAST 4 YEARS OLD BUT NOT MORE THAN 14 YEARS OLD.

(C) (B) (1) EACH COUNTY SHALL APPOINT A PLAN COORDINATOR WHO SHALL COORDINATE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PLAN WITH THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES IN THE COUNTY CONSIDER, IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEEDS ASSESSMENT, THE SERVICES OF:
