- (a) In this section, "foster parent" includes an individual who cares for a child on an emergency basis under a shelter care program.
- (b) (1) The [Administration] AGENCY shall provide liability insurance for foster parents who care for children under foster parent programs.
- (2) Subject to a reasonable deductible limit, which the [Administration] AGENCY shall set, the liability insurance shall provide coverage for:
- (i) Bodily injury and property damage that a foster child causes to the person or property of a person other than a foster parent; and
