- (ii) Actions against a foster parent by a natural parent for any accident to the foster child.
- (c) (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, the [Secretary] DIRECTOR shall reimburse a foster parent for costs of bodily injury of property damage that the foster child causes to the foster parent and that insurance does not cover.
- (2) Before reimbursement under this subsection, the [Secretary] DIRECTOR shall be satisfied that the actions of the foster parent did not contribute substantially to the bodily injury or property damage sustained.
- (3) Reimbursement under this subsection shall be made for all costs to a maximum amount of \$5,000. However, all payments in excess of \$500 require the approval of the Board of Public Works.
