[(iii)] (IV) The residential school located within the Institute of Psychiatry and Human Behavior of the University Hospital.

(b) (3) The following officials shall serve ex officio and each may designate someone to serve in his place:

(iii) The Director of the Juvenile Services [Administration] AGENCY;

(vii) Two county superintendents of schools from counties where a State hospital center or a juvenile residential institution of the [Department of Health and Mental Hygiene] JUVENILE SERVICES AGENCY is located, who shall be selected by the State Superintendent of Schools.

(a) (2) Funds for the operation of the educational programs in State juvenile residential institutions shall be provided in the budget of the Juvenile Services [Administration] AGENCY.
