

(e) For each vehicle registered under this section, the annual registration fee is the greater of:

(1) \$16.50 for each thousand pounds of gross weight of the vehicle, or

(2) \$660.

(a) In this section, "farm truck" means a farm vehicle that:

(1) is a Class E (truck) vehicle, and

(2) has a shipping weight of its chassis and battery, as certified by the manufacturer, of more than 3/4 ton.

(c) For each vehicle registered under this section, the annual registration fee is based on the maximum gross vehicle weight, as follows:

(a) When registered with the Administration, every truck tractor or similar motor vehicle used for propelling, supporting, or drawing a trailer or semitrailer is a Class F (tractor) vehicle.

(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, for each Class F (tractor) vehicle, the annual registration fee is based on the maximum gross weight of the vehicle in combination with a trailer or semitrailer, as follows:

Maximum Gross Weight ----- Fee (per 1,000 Pounds
Limit (in Pounds) ----- or Fraction Thereof)

40,000 (minimum) -- 60,000 ----- \$9.00 \$11.00

60,001 -- 73,000 ----- \$9.50 \$11.50

73,001 -- 80,000 ----- \$10.00 \$12.00

(c) For truck tractors registered under § 13-423 of this article, the annual registration fee is based on the maximum gross weight of the vehicle in combination with a trailer or semitrailer, as follows:
