This article shall be administered and implemented by the following three ethics agencies:

(1) The Joint Committee on Legislative Ethics, acting as an advisory body as to the application of the provisions of Title 3 of this article to members of the General Assembly, within the limitations and procedures prescribed by this article;

(2) The Judicial Disabilities Commission or a body to be designated by the Court of Appeals, acting as an advisory body as to the application of the provisions of Titles 3 and 4 to State officials of the judicial branch, within the limitations and procedures prescribed by this article; AND

(3) The State Ethics Commission, established pursuant to Section 2-102 of this article, as to all other matters prescribed by this article.

DRAFTER'S NOTE: This corrects the omission of a conjunction in Article 40A, § 2-101.

The conjunction, "and", was omitted from Ch. 513 of the Acts of 1979.

The omission of the conjunction was noted by the Michie Company.
