AN ACT concerning

Incinerators - Permits - Hearings

FOR the purpose of requiring-the-Department-of-Health-and-Mental Hygiene-to-issue-permits-to-construct-incinerators-that-burn solid--waste; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to give-certain-notice--and--to provide a certain hearing before issuing certain-permits a permit for an incinerator for public use that burns solid waste; and generally relating to issuance of permits and hearings concerning incinerators for public use.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(1)--GIVE--PUBLIC--NOTICE--OF-THE-INTENDED-ISSUANCE-OF THE-PERMIT;-AND

(2)--PROVIDE-AN-OPPORTUNITY-FOR-A--PUBLIC--HEARING--IN THE-COUNTY-IN-WHICH-THE-PROPOSED-SOURCE-WILL-BE-LOCATED.

(a) Before the Department issues a permit to an applicant under § 9-204 of this subtitle to install, materially alter, or materially extend a landfill system, OR AN INCINERATOR FOR PUBLIC USE TO BURN SOLID WASTE, the Department shall hold a public hearing on the application.
