

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) "Cold storage" means storing, placing, or keeping in a cold storage warehouse at a temperature that does not exceed 45 degrees Fahrenheit.

(c) "Food" means any food that is listed in § 4-502 of this subtitle.

(d) "Cold storage warehouse" means an artificially cooled place in which food is placed in cold storage for 30 days or more.

(e) "License" means a license issued by the Secretary under this subtitle.]

[4-502.

This subtitle applies only to the cold storage of:

- (1) Butter;
- (2) Eggs;
- (3) Fish;
- (4) Fresh meat;
- (5) Fresh meat products;
- (6) Game; and
- (7) Poultry.]

[4-503.

The Secretary may adopt the rules and regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this subtitle.]

[Part II. Licensing]

[4-506.

(a) A person shall be licensed by the Secretary before the person may operate a cold storage warehouse in this State.

(b) A separate license is required for each cold storage warehouse the person operates.]
