

(2) The date by which the renewal application must be received by the Secretary for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and

(3) The amount of the renewal fee.

(c) Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 1-year term, if the licensee:

(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(2) Pays to the Secretary a renewal fee of \$25; and

(3) Submits to the Secretary a renewal application on the form that the Secretary requires.

(d) The Secretary shall renew the license of each licensee who meets the requirements of this section.]

If the Secretary finds that a cold storage warehouse is in an unsanitary condition or not equipped properly, the Secretary shall notify the licensee:

(1) Of the specific findings;

(2) Of a specific date by which the licensee shall correct the deficiencies specified in the notice; and

(3) That, if the licensee fails to correct the conditions by the date specified, the license will be revoked.]
