- (a) (1) In each room where food is packed, preserved, or otherwise manufactured, the licensee shall have floors that are smooth, impervious, and easily cleaned.
- (2) Each licensee shall maintain, for each sex of employees:
  - (i) Clothes changing facilities;
  - (ii) Wash stations; and
  - (iii) Separate toilets.
- (3) Each licensee shall maintain drainage that is adequate to lead all waste liquids away from the building to the outside.
