- (a) Except as otherwise provided in the Administrative Procedure Act, before the Secretary takes any action under § 4-714 of this subtitle, the Secretary shall give the licensee against whom the action is contemplated an opportunity for a hearing before the Secretary.

- (c) The Secretary shall send the hearing notice to the licensee by certified mail, return receipt requested, bearing a postmark from the United States Postal Service.]

- (a) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Secretary in denying or revoking a license may take a judicial appeal.
