

A person who violates any provision of § 4-901, § 4-902, or § 4-904 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:

- or
- (1) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$1,000;
 - (2) For a subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$5,000.]

A person who violates any provision of Subtitle 5 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:

- or
- (1) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$100;
 - (2) For a subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or both.]

A person who violates any provision of Subtitle 6 of this title or any provision of Subtitle 1 of this title, except § 4-114 is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:

- or
- (1) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$250;
 - (2) For a second offense, a fine not exceeding \$500;
 - (3) For a third offense or an offense subsequent to the third offense, a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.]

A person who violates any provision of Subtitle 3 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100 or imprisonment in jail not exceeding 90 days or both.]

A person who violates any provision of § 4-1002 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.]
