

(II) DISCLOSES ALL SIDE EFFECTS, WARNINGS, AND CAUTIONS FOR A BREAST IMPLANTATION OPERATION;

(2) EACH-YEAR UPDATE AS NECESSARY THE STANDARDIZED WRITTEN SUMMARY; AND

(3) DISTRIBUTE THE STANDARDIZED WRITTEN SUMMARY TO EACH HOSPITAL, CLINIC, AND PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE AND ANY OTHER FACILITY THAT PERFORMS BREAST IMPLANTATIONS.

(C) A PHYSICIAN SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION IF:

(1) THE PHYSICIAN PROVIDES THE BREAST IMPLANTATION PATIENT WITH THE STANDARDIZED WRITTEN SUMMARY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION;

(2) THE PATIENT RECEIVES THE STANDARDIZED WRITTEN SUMMARY 5 DAYS BEFORE THE BREAST IMPLANTATION OPERATION; AND

(3) THE PATIENT SIGNS A STATEMENT PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT ACKNOWLEDGING THE RECEIPT OF THE STANDARDIZED WRITTEN SUMMARY.

~~(D) -- A PHYSICIAN WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 14-504(29) OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be regarded as supplemental and additional to the requirements established by other laws upon a physician and may not be regarded as in derogation or substitution of any requirement now existing upon a physician.
