- (b) (2) Prior to publication pursuant to [§ 245 of this article] §§ 10-111(A) AND 10-112 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, there shall be submitted to the Secretary any proposed rule or regulation of any of the divisions, boards, commissions, offices, and other agencies within the jurisdiction of the Department. When the rule or regulation pertains to the regulatory, supervisory, quasi-judicial, disciplinary or enforcement duty or function of such division, board, commission, offices, or other agencies, the Secretary may, within 30 days after presentation, disapprove any rule or regulation if he determines that it:
- (i) Would discourage competition within a licensed or regulated occupation or profession;
- (ii) Would unfairly restrict entry of applicants into a licensed or regulated occupation or profession; or
- (iii) Is otherwise contrary to the public interest.
