(g) If, after due notice, the individual against whom the action is contemplated fails or refuses to appear, the Board may hear and determine the matter.

## [5.5-314] 11-314.

- (a) Except as provided in this section for an action under § [5.5-312] 11-312 of this subtitle, any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board in a contested case, as defined in the Administrative Procedure Act, may:
  - (1) Appeal that decision to the Board of Review; and
- (2) Then take any further appeal allowed by the Administrative Procedure Act.
- (b) (1) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board under  $\S$  [5.5-312] 11-312 of this subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary or Board of Review but may take a direct judicial appeal.
- (2) The appeal shall be made as provided for judicial review of final decisions in the Administrative Procedure Act.

[5.5-315] 11-315.

The Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reinstate the license of an individual whose license has been revoked.

Subtitle 4. Prohibited Acts; Penalties

[5.5-401] 11-401.

- (a) Unless a person is licensed under this title, the person may not represent to the public that the person is a registered environmental sanitarian.
- (b) Unless a person is licensed under this title, the person may not use the title "registered environmental sanitarian" or the initials "R.S." after the name of the person.

[5.5-402] 11-402.

A person who violates any provision of § [5.5-301] 11-301 or § [5.5-401] 11-401 of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100 or imprisonment not exceeding 60 days or both.

Subtitle 5. Short Title; Termination of Title [5.5-501] 11-501.
