(vii) Industrial wastewater superintendents; and

(viii) The Department of Natural Resources.

- (3) The Secretary shall appoint:
 - (i) 1 engineer member from the Department; and
- (ii) 2 public members who represent the community at large.
- (b) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board shall the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the State Constitution.
- (c) (l) The term of a member appointed by the Governor is 4 years.
- The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1981. The terms of those members end as follows:
 - (i) Three in 1982;
 - (ii) One in 1983;
 - (iii) One in 1984; and
 - (iv) Two in 1985.
- At the end of a term, a member appointed by Governor continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed by the Governor after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (d) The members appointed by the Secretary serve at the pleasure of the Secretary.
- The Governor may remove for incompetence or misconduct a member appointed by the Governor.

- (a) From among its members, the Board annually shall elect a chairman.
- The Secretary of [Health and Mental Hygiene] THE ENVIRONMENT shall designate a representative of the Department as Board secretary.
