requirements, ordinances, regulations or statutes are set forth, remain reserved to city and county government.

(f) The Department shall establish a schedule of fees for administration of the inspection and certification program for industrialized buildings and the on-site inspection and enforcement program for mobile homes. To the extent possible, the fees will be based on the cost of administration of these programs and the payments of the fees shall be included with receipts from contracts or grants under federal or interstate programs in the funds of the Department. Any funds unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall not revert but instead, shall be maintained in a special fund available to the Department for carrying out the purposes of this [subheading] SUBTITLE.

11-505.

- (a) In carrying out his duties under this [subheading] SUBTITLE, the Secretary shall have the assistance of an Advisory Commission on Industrialized Building and Mobile Homes, which is hereby created. Members of the Advisory Commission shall appointed by the Secretary and shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred while engaged the performance of their duties in accordance with the Standard Travel Regulations. Members appointed shall be representative of the industries and professions involved in the development and construction of industrialized buildings and mobile homes and shall also include representatives from building enforcement agencies, architectural and engineering associations, building construction trades, the contracting manufacturing industries, legislative bodies of local government, the financial industry and the general public.
- (b) The Advisory Commission shall make recommendations to the Secretary regarding the rules and regulations as promulgated under this [subheading] SUBTITLE as it shall from time to time deem necessary or desirable. The Advisory Commission shall submit an annual report to the Secretary and, subject to § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly regarding rules, regulations, and programs relating to this [subheading] SUBTITLE.

11-506.

- (a) The Secretary shall enforce the provisions of this [subheading] SUBTITLE and the rules and regulations adopted under it. The Secretary, on information, may refer an apparent violation to the appropriate State's attorney.
- (b) Any person who violates any provisions of the [subheading] SUBTITLE or any rule or regulation adopted under it is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction for each offense
