- (1) The President of the Senate, ex officio;
- (2) The Speaker of the House, ex officio;
- (3) The Secretaries of Agriculture, [Health and Mental Hygiene] THE ENVIRONMENT, and Natural Resources, ex officio, or their designees;
- (4) 10 individuals appointed by the Governor, who shall represent the interests of local government, education, business, environmental conservation, and the general public.
- (c) The Governor shall consider geographical balance in making appointments to the Board of Trustees.
 - (d) Except for the ex officio members or their designees:
 - (1) The term of a member is 4 years;
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1985;
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies;
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term is begun serves for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and
 - (5) A member may serve no more than 2 terms.

Article - State Government

8-201.

- (a) The Executive Branch of the State government shall have not more than [20] 21 principal departments, each of which shall embrace a broad, functional area of that Branch.
