- (b) The Department of Economic and Community Development shall manage and supervise the Maryland Housing Fund. The fund shall be deposited with the State Treasurer to be held in such banks as he deems proper and shall be accounted for by the State Comptroller in a special account known as the "Maryland Housing Fund". The fund shall be invested and reinvested in the same manner as other State funds. The funds shall be used to insure mortgages accepted by the Department under the provisions of this [subheading] SUBTITLE, or to insure bonds or notes issued to finance any project that is eligible for insurance under the provisions of this section. The fund shall be managed in a manner which maximizes assistance to local jurisdictions in insuring mortgages under the provisions of this section.
