to them, and each of them, the performance subject to his discretion and control, of any of the duties with respect to said Department required of him by law. All such assistant attorneys general shall be practicing lawyers of the State of Maryland, in good standing, and they shall receive such compensation as shall be provided in the State budget.

(C) This section [shall] DOES not apply to any divisions, commissions, boards, authorities or other agencies within the Department [of Economic and Community Development] to the extent that such divisions, commissions, boards, authorities or other agencies are authorized by law to employ their own legal advisers or counsel.
