

(3) ANY SUCH REMOVAL BY THE SECRETARY OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT IS FINAL AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY APPEAL.

(B) THE DIRECTOR SHALL BE SELECTED BECAUSE OF KNOWN EXPERIENCE AND INTEREST IN EMPLOYMENT AND JOB TRAINING.

(C) THE DIRECTOR SHALL OPERATE THIS DIVISION UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE SECRETARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT.

3-103.

THE DIVISION SHALL:

(1) ADMINISTER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 95A OF THIS CODE;

(2) PROMOTE APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING PROGRAMS;

(3) ADMINISTER JOB TRAINING, PLACEMENT, AND SERVICE PROGRAMS;

(4) IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT;

(5) OVERSEE ANY OTHER UNITS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO STATE OR FEDERAL EMPLOYMENT, TRAINING, OR MANPOWER STATUTES; AND

(6) ADMINISTER THOSE PROGRAMS ASSIGNED TO THE DIVISION BY LAW OR DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY.

3-104.

THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION SHALL RECEIVE THE SALARY AND HAVE THE DEPUTIES, ASSISTANTS, AND EMPLOYEES PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

Subtitle 2. Retraining of Unemployed Workers

[7-201.] 3-201.

(a) (1) In this section, the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) "Facility" means any State agency or portion of a State agency where 50 or more classified or unclassified State employees regularly work.

(3) "Employee" means any permanent full-time or part-time employee for whom a position is provided in the State budget.
