

(2) A resident of the county from which the member is appointed.

(d) Before taking office, each appointee to the Advisory Committee shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the State Constitution.

(e) (1) The term of a member is 5 years.

(2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1984.

(3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(f) The Board of County Commissioners in Somerset and Worcester counties and the County Council in Wicomico County may remove a member from their respective county for incompetence or misconduct.

(g) The Advisory Committee shall advise and counsel the Department [of Economic and Community Development] on the development and operation of the Maryland Lower Eastern Shore Tourism Center.

Subtitle [2.] 3. Motion Picture and Television Development Office
and Advisory Council

There is a Motion Picture and Television Development Office and a Motion Picture and Television Development and Advisory Council within the Department [of Economic and Community Development].

[13-202.] 4-302.

(a) The Council consists of 12 members appointed for 2-year terms as follows:

(1) One is a member of the Senate and is appointed by the President of the Senate;

(2) One is a member of the House of Delegates and is appointed by the Speaker;

(3) Ten are appointed by the Secretary [of Economic and Community Development] with the approval of the Governor and the advice and consent of the Senate, and include representatives
