- (1) Withhold from the applicant further loan guarantees until the applicant complies with the agreement or requirements; and
- (2) Exercise any other remedy for which the loan guarantee agreement provides.

(c) Any person or any aider and abettor, who violates any provision of this [subheading] SUBTITLE, is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$50,000 or imprisonment in the penitentiary not exceeding 5 years, or both.
