

- (5) MARYLAND HOUSING FUND;
- (6) DIVISION OF COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE;
- (7) DIVISION OF CULTURAL ACTIVITIES;
- (8) ST. MARY'S CITY COMMISSION;
- (9) COMMISSION ON AFRO-AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURE;
- (10) COMMISSION ON INDIAN AFFAIRS;
- (11) MARYLAND ETHNIC HERITAGE COMMISSION; AND
- (12) MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALSO INCLUDE SUCH OTHER AGENCIES, COMMISSIONS, BOARDS, COMMITTEES, COUNCILS, OR UNITS OF GOVERNMENT AS MAY HEREAFTER PURSUANT TO LAW BE DECLARED TO BE PART OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH THE ADVISORY COUNCILS, BOARDS, AND COMMITTEES AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE GOVERNOR AND THE SECRETARY.

(2) THE ADVISORY BODIES SHALL ADVISE AND ASSIST THE SECRETARY ON MATTERS PERTAINING TO POLICIES, PROGRAMS, AND ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(3) THE SIZE, QUALIFICATIONS, METHOD OF APPOINTMENT, TERMS, COMPENSATION, MANNER OF REMOVAL, METHOD OF FILLING VACANCIES SHALL BE AS DETERMINED BY THE GOVERNOR AND THE SECRETARY.

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(A) THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BUDGET OF THE OFFICE AND FOR THE BUDGETS OF THE OTHER BOARDS, OFFICES, AND AGENCIES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(B) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR THE OFFICE. THE SECRETARY SHALL REVIEW AND SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE OR REVISE THE REGULATIONS OF ALL OF THE BOARDS, OFFICES, AGENCIES, COMMISSIONS, ETC. WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) THE SECRETARY SHALL HAVE A SEAL FOR PURPOSES OF AUTHENTICATION OF COPIES OF RECORDS OR PAPERS IN THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE.

(D) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COORDINATION AND DIRECTION OF ALL PLANNING FACILITIES INITIATED BY THE SECRETARY.
