

(4) [To cause] CAUSE the prosecution of all violators of this subtitle.

(b) On and after July 1, 1969, each boiler and pressure vessel used or proposed to be used within this State, except boilers and pressure vessels exempt under § 172 of this subtitle, shall be thoroughly inspected as to their construction, installation and condition, as follows:

(7) A grace period of two months beyond the periods specified in [subdivisions (1), (2), (3) and (6)] PARAGRAPH (1), (2), (3), AND (6) of this subsection may elapse between certificate inspections.
