Section 2-907 and 2-908
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1984 Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

2-907.

There is an Advisory Commission on [Federal-Local] FEDERAL-STATE-LOCAL Relations.

2-908.

(a) The Commission consists of [an equal number of senators and delegates.

(b) (1) The President shall appoint the senators on the Commission.

(2) The Speaker shall appoint the delegates on the Commission.] THE FOLLOWING 12 MEMBERS:

(1) 4 SENATORS, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(2) 4 DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES;

(3) AS EX OFFICIO MEMBERS:

(I) THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING; AND

(II) THE SECRETARY OF STATE PLANNING;

(4) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION; AND

(5) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE LEAGUE.

(B) (1) THE TERMS OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES AND THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE ARE 4 YEARS.

(2) AT THE END OF A TERM, A REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
