THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALVERT COUNTY, BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION, MAY FIX, IMPOSE, AND COLLECT DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES FOR FINANCING, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, THE CAPITAL COSTS OF ADDITIONAL OR EXPANDED PUBLIC WORKS, IMPROVEMENTS, AND FACILITIES REQUIRED TO ACCOMMODATE NEW CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT.

----SECTION--2---AND--BE--IT--FURTHER-ENACTED,-That-the-Calvert County--Commissioners--shall--submit--to---the---Calvert---County Delegation--of--the--General--Assembly--an--annual-written-report concerning-the-implementation-and-effect-of-this-Act---The-report shall-be-submitted-on-or--before--commencement--of--each--regular legislative-session-in-1988,-1989,-and-1990.

There is a Board of Trustees of State Universities and Colleges which exercises direction and control of:
