CHAPTER 334

(Senate Bill 213)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Regulation of Smoking

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners for Washington County to enact ordinances governing regulating smoking in County offices and County office buildings; and generally relating to smoking in County offices in Washington County.

BY adding to

Article 25 - County Commissioners Section 236B Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

236B.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY MAY ENACT ORDINANCES GOVERNING REGULATING SMOKING IN COUNTY OFFICES AND COUNTY OFFICE BUILDINGS. ANY ORDINANCE ENACTED SHALL ASSURE AND PROVIDE FOR EMPLOYEES AND THE PUBLIC TO SMOKE IN DESIGNATED SMOKING PLACES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
