LAWS OF MARYLAND

BEGINNING ON THE SHORE OF THE POTOMAC RIVER AT THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE ABANDONED WESTERN MARYLAND RAILROAD BED, NOW OWNED BY THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, THEN FOLLOWING THE POTOMAC SHORE UPRIVER AND AROUND THE ENTIRE SINUOUS PENINSULA TO THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE SOUTH END OF THE PROPERTY NOW OWNED BY THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, THEN FOLLOWING THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE BOUNDARY INLAND IN FIRST A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION, THEN NORTHWEST TO THE WESTERN MARYLAND RAILROAD BED, AND THEN NORTHEAST FOLLOWING THAT BOUNDARY BACK TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, MEANING TO INCLUDE ALL STATE-OWNED AND ONLY STATE-OWNED LANDS WITHIN THIS DESCRIBED PENINSUL\.

THE WILDLAND EXCLUDES THE FOLLOWING---3---NONSTATE-OWNED PROPERTIES:

- (1)--ONE--APPROXIMATELY--11--ACRE--LOT-PRIVATELY-OWNED (OWNER-UNKNOWN);
- (2) APPROXIMATELY 23 ACRES PRIVATELY OWNED BY THE BALTIMORE & OHIO RAILROAD; -AND
- (3)--APPROXIMATELY-40-ACRES-OWNED-BY-THE-NATIONAL-PARK SERVICE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
