

(b) Before any individual is eligible for a certificate to act as agent or broker as to life and health insurance or annuities, he shall, except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, meet the qualifications prescribed in § 178 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(d) An individual who meets the qualifications prescribed by this subtitle shall be eligible for a certificate as agent in the kind or kinds of insurance for which the individual has qualified; and if qualified in the various kinds of insurance stated in [§ 168(c)] § 168(A) of this subtitle the individual shall be eligible for license as a broker.

(e) The Commissioner may require an examination to establish the competency of an individual whose certificate has been terminated under § 170(c) OF THIS SUBTITLE. In cases where the license has been suspended or revoked as provided in § 175 OF THIS SUBTITLE, the Commissioner may in his discretion require the applicant to pass an examination and file a new application before reinstatement.
