AN ACT concerning

- Ereation-of-a-State-Debt Prince George's County Black Historic Site Restoration Loan of 1985 - Ridgely Methodist Episcopal Memorial--Black-Historic-Site-Restoration
- the purpose of authorizing-the-creation-of-a-State-Debt-in the-amount-of-\$15070007-the-proceeds-to-be-used-as-a-grant to-the-Ridgely-Methodist-Episcopal-Memorial-in-Prince George's-County-to-assist-in-the-restoration;-improvement; renovation-and-equipping-of-that-Black-historic-site; subject-to-the-requirement-that-the-Ridgely-Methodist Episcopal-Memorial-provide-at-least-an-equal-and-matching fund-of-a-certain-kind-for-the-same-purpose-by-a-certain date;-providing-that-no-proceeds-of-the-loan-or-any-of-the matching-funds-be-used-for-certain-religious-purposes amending the provisions of the Prince George's County-Black Historic Site Restoration Loan of 1985, as amended, to require the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to provide certain funds to the Ridgely Methodist Episcopal Memorial; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
