- (b) The same information may be extracted from any death certificates in the custody of the State Archives for use by researchers.
- (c) The State Archives shall bear any cost incurred under this section.
- (d) (1) Information made available under this section to researchers does not constitute official records.
- (2) Use and publication of the extracted information does not violate this article.
- (3) Use of photographic copies of certificates by the staff of the State Archives in preparing the extracts does not violate this article.
- (e) The State Archives may not provide information under this section to any person for commercial solicitation or private gain.]

 - (II) OCCUPATIONS:
 - (III) PLACES OF RESIDENCE;
- OR DEATH; (IV) DATE AND PLACE OF BIRTH, MARRIAGE, DIVORCE

OR DEATH;

RECORD: AND

- (V) FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS AS STATED IN THE
 - (VI) NAME AND RELATIONSHIP OF THE INFORMANT.
- OF THE ARCHIVES, INCLUDING ONE OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT BY THE ARCHIVES, THAT PERTAINS TO A BIRTH THAT OCCURRED MORE THAN 100 YEARS AGO, TO A MARRIAGE OR DIVORCE THAT OCCURRED MORE THAN 60 YEARS AGO, OR TO A DEATH THAT OCCURRED MORE THAN 20 YEARS AGO.
