

THE BOARD FOR REINSTATEMENT MORE THAN 90 DAYS AFTER THE LICENSE HAS EXPIRED, THE BOARD MAY:

(I) REQUIRE THE INDIVIDUAL TO REAPPLY FOR A LICENSE IN THE SAME MANNER AS AN APPLICANT APPLIES FOR AN ORIGINAL LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, IF THE INDIVIDUAL DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR REINSTATEMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION; OR

(II) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, REINSTATE THE LICENSE.

(2) THE BOARD MAY REINSTATE A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION ONLY IF THE MASTER ELECTRICIAN:

(I) MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION;

(II) SHOWS JUST CAUSE TO THE BOARD WHY REINSTATEMENT SHOULD BE GRANTED; AND

(III) PAYS TO THE BOARD, IN ADDITION TO ALL PAST DUE RENEWAL FEES, A REINSTATEMENT FEE OF \$300.

(A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, ON THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD, THE BOARD MAY WAIVE THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED TO INSTALL, REPAIR, MAINTAIN, OR ERECT ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AS A MASTER ELECTRICIAN IN ANOTHER STATE, INCLUDING THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.

(B) THE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS SECTION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) PAYS THE APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY §§ 536, 536A, AND 540A OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(2) PROVIDES ADEQUATE EVIDENCE THAT THE APPLICANT:

(I) MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE;

(II) HOLDS AN ACTIVE LICENSE IN GOOD STANDING IN THE OTHER STATE;

(III) HOLDS A LICENSE THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO THE LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND
