

THE YEAR THAT SUPERINTENDENT'S TERM ENDS, THE HARFORD COUNTY BOARD SHALL PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE IN 2 NEWSPAPERS OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY THAT THE BOARD WILL CONDUCT AN EVALUATION OF THE SUPERINTENDENT'S PROFESSIONAL PERFORMANCE.

(III) BY FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR SPECIFIED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE HARFORD COUNTY BOARD SHALL:

1. CONDUCT AN EVALUATION OF THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT'S PROFESSIONAL PERFORMANCE; AND

2. SHARE THE FINDINGS OF THE EVALUATION WITH THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT.

(IV) 1. BY DECEMBER 1 OF THE YEAR PRECEDING A YEAR IN WHICH THE TERM ENDS, THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOTIFY THE COUNTY BOARD WHETHER THE SUPERINTENDENT IS A CANDIDATE FOR REAPPOINTMENT. IF THE SUPERINTENDENT NOTIFIES THE COUNTY BOARD THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT IS NOT A CANDIDATE FOR REAPPOINTMENT, THEN THE REMAINING PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT APPLY.

2. THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE IN 2 NEWSPAPERS OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY WHETHER THE SUPERINTENDENT IS A CANDIDATE FOR REAPPOINTMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
