CHAPTER 398

(Senate Bill 842)

AN ACT concerning

Absentee Ballots

FOR the purpose of adding computer read documents to the types of absentee ballots that may be used in elections in this State; requiring all types of absentee ballots to contain specific instructional information; clarifying references to certain post offices; altering a definition; clarifying language; and generally relating to absentee ballots.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code
