Tenant Evictions - Inclement-Weather Extreme Weather Conditions.

the purpose of authorizing-evicting-officers-to-delay implementation-of-warrants-for-repossession-of-leased premises-because-of-inclement-weather-conditions;--and defining-certain-terms providing that, in the case of a landlord removing a tenant for failure to pay rent, the administrative judge of the district may stay the execution of a warrant of restitution, in a certain manner, in the event of extreme weather conditions; providing-that-the judge-shall-promptly-direct-rescheduling-of-the-execution-of the-warrant-at-a-certain-time providing for priority of the execution of a certain warrant of restitution under certain circumstances; and generally relating to removal of a tenant for failure to pay rent.
