

and the corporation or partnership may contract for and to collect fees for architectural services.

(4) A certificate of authorization shall expire on June 30 of each even-numbered year.

(5) No corporation or partnership is relieved of responsibility for conduct or acts of its agents, employees or officers by reason of its compliance with the provisions of this section, nor is any individual who is practicing architecture as defined in § 464 of this subtitle relieved of responsibility for architectural services performed by reason of his employment or relationship with such corporation or partnership.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 423

(Senate Bill 1011)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Retail Delivery

FOR the purpose of deleting Garrett County from those counties that prohibit any retail delivery of alcoholic beverages to a purchaser unless the retail dealer is authorized to sell and distribute in that county; and providing for a delayed effective date.
