- (iii) Fondling or other erotic touching of human genitals.
 - (2) "Distributing" includes renting.
 - (3) "Nude or partially denuded figures" means:
- (i) Less than completely and opaquely covered human genitals, pubic region, buttocks, or female breast below a point immediately above the top of the areola; or
- (ii) Human male genitals in a discernibly turgid state, even if completely and opaquely covered.
 - (4) "OBSCENE" MEANS:
- (I) THAT THE AVERAGE ADULT APPLYING CONTEMPORARY COMMUNITY STANDARDS WOULD FIND THAT THE WORK, TAKEN AS A WHOLE, APPEALS TO THE PRURIENT INTEREST OF-MINORS;
- (II) THAT THE WORK DEPICTS THE SEXUAL CONDUCT SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IN A WAY THAT IS PATENTLY OFFENSIVE TO PREVAILING STANDARDS IN THE ADULT COMMUNITY AS A WHOLE WITH RESPECT TO WHAT IS SUITABLE MATERIAL FOR--MINORS; AND
- (III) THAT THE WORK, TAKEN AS A WHOLE, LACKS SERIOUS LITERARY, SCIENTIFIC, EDUCATIONAL, ARTISTIC, OR POLITICAL VALUE FOR-MINORS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 431

(House Bill 103)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Wine License

FOR the purpose of clarifying that a holder of a Class 3 or Class 4 manufacturer's license who makes wine from Maryland grown agricultural products is eligible for issuance of a Class A light wine license in Washington County; permitting Sunday 'sales' under 'this license without an additional fee; clarifying certain provisions of law that apply to days and
