

IMMEDIATELY SHALL ADD OR REMOVE THE PERSON AND NOTIFY THE PERSON, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL, OF THE BOARD'S ACTION.

(4) If the board is satisfied that the person [so] challenged:[, omitted or dropped from the registration lists]

[and] (I) has [actually] moved to another precinct;

(II) is presently residing within that other precinct[,]; AND

(III) IS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE, the board [may] SHALL transfer that person to the registration list of the precinct in which he presently resides.

[(e) Objections to the registration of any person shall be made on a form prescribed by the State Administrative Board of Election Laws.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 438

(House Bill 160)

AN ACT concerning

Property Tax Refund - Disabled Veterans

FOR the purpose of requiring a county or municipal corporation to pay interest on certain property tax refunds to certain disabled veterans or their surviving spouses, if the refund is not paid within a certain period after an application is filed; specifying the rate at which the interest shall be paid and the date on which it begins accruing; and generally relating to the refund of property tax to certain disabled veterans or their surviving spouses.
