## CHAPTER 444

(House Bill 218) .

AN ACT concerning

Community Adult Rehabilitation Centers - Placement

FOR the purpose of altering certain conditions for the placement of individuals in community adult rehabilitation centers; clarifying certain provisions; and making stylistic changes.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments Section 710C Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

710C.

- (a) A person may be placed in a center BY THE  $\,$  COMMISSIONER if the person:
- (1) Is considered a resident of the county in which the center is located, or if a regional center, one of the counties comprising the region;
- (2) Has less than 6 months remaining on the sentence or less than 6 months remaining until a determined parole date, or has a sentence of [18] 36 months or less; and
- (3) Has been screened by a center staff member and after review of the screening data, the center director approves the transfer based upon screening standards agreed to by the community advisory board, the center director and the Commissioner. The screening standards shall include a presentence investigation report if available and a complete record of previous convictions.
