(b) The refund shall be a percent of the tax on motor vehicle fuel as follows:

(1) 10 percent from July 1, 1986 through June 30, 1987;

(2) 18 percent from July 1, 1987 through June 30, 1988; and

(3) 25 percent beginning on July 1, 1988 through June 30, 1989.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect all taxable years beginning on or after July 1, 1986.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
