

(A) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD FOR THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL ANNAPOLIS WINE FESTIVAL (AWF) LICENSE.

(B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION ~~TO THE CONTRARY~~ OF THIS ARTICLE, AN APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL (AWF) LICENSE SHALL BE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING STATE RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, STATE CLASS 3 WINERY LICENSE, OR STATE CLASS 4 WINERY LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT ~~TO~~ UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

(C) A SPECIAL (AWF) LICENSEE SHALL:

(1) ONLY DISPLAY AND SELL WINE THAT IS MANUFACTURED AND PROCESSED IN MARYLAND; AND

(2) DISPLAY AND SELL WINE AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE ANNAPOLIS WINE FESTIVAL.

~~(E) -- THE LICENSE FEE IS \$100.~~

~~(F)~~ (E) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL (AWF) LICENSE FROM HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT CLASS OR NATURE.

~~(G)~~ (F) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD FOR THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS:

(1) MAY ESTABLISH THE LICENSE FEE;

~~(1)~~ (2) MAY SELECT ONE WEEKEND ANNUALLY FOR THE ANNAPOLIS WINE FESTIVAL PROVIDED THAT THE WEEKEND THAT IS SELECTED DOES NOT:

(I) CONFLICT WITH THE DATES OF THE MARYLAND WINE FESTIVAL; OR

(II) FALL ON THE LAST WEEKEND IN MAY OR THE FIRST WEEKEND IN JUNE; AND

~~(2)~~ (3) SHALL CHOOSE A LOCATION IN THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS FOR THIS FESTIVAL WHICH IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

~~(H)~~ (G) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
