(3) REDUCED RATES FOR RECIPIENTS OF SERVICES SHALL BE APPLIED FAIRLY AND UNIFORMLY, AND ACCORDING TO THE SLIDING FEE SCALE DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

The Secretary shall:

(1) Report the findings of the assessment to the General Assembly on or before November 1, 1988 1987;

(2) Consult with the appropriate county and state groups to develop recommendations to implement the findings of the assessment; and

(3) Report to the General Assembly on February 1, 1988 on the progress towards implementation of the recommendations.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

(House Bill 472)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Credit Services Businesses - Regulation

FOR the purpose of providing certain protections to the consumers of credit services businesses; requiring credit services businesses to provide certain information to customers; establishing certain requirements for contracts between credit services businesses and consumers; requiring a surety bond or trust account in certain circumstances; defining certain terms; providing certain civil and criminal
