

(5) The payment of any funds, under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, shall be contingent upon the provision by the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County of a sum up to \$70,000 as a matching fund for this project. No part of the applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from State funds, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the applicant's matching fund may consist of real property or in kind contributions. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as the applicant's matching fund, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County have until June 1, [1987] 1988, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works of the sum that it has raised as a matching fund for this purpose. Upon a certification of suitable evidence from the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, [1987] 1988, the proceeds of the loan shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of this Act. To the extent that satisfactory evidence of the raising of a sum up to \$70,000 as a matching fund for this project is not presented to the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, [1987] 1988, no funds under the provisions of this Act shall thereafter be paid over to or expended for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, and the remaining proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in Article 78A, § 3 of the Code. Furthermore, the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County shall grant and convey a perpetual preservation easement on the exterior and interior of ~~the structures,~~ where appropriate, and on the land to the Maryland Historical Trust, in form and substance acceptable to the Trust--} ~~AN--EXISTING STRUCTURE--ON--THE--HANNAH--MORE--PROPERTY--WHICH--IS--TO--BE--USED--FOR--A YOUTH-CENTER.~~
