- (1) "Audiological";
- (2) "Audiologist";
- (3) "Audiology";
- (4) "Hearing clinic";
- (5) "Hearing clinician";
- (6) "Hearing or aural rehabilitation"; or
- (7) "Hearing specialist".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 478

(House Bill 546)

AN ACT concerning

Speech-Language Pathology

FOR the purpose of changing references to speech pathology or speech pathologists to speech-language pathology and speech-language pathologists, respectively; altering the definition of speech-language pathology; altering the qualifications for the speech-language pathologist and audiologist member of the State Board of Examiners for Speech Pathologists; altering the education requirements for obtaining a license to practice speech-language pathology;
