(b) It is unlawful for any liquor licensee under this article to employ any person under the age of [21 years and for any other class of licensee to employ any person not designated under § 2(t)(2) of this article in the sale of alcoholic beverages or in connection with the business] 18 YEARS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

(House Bill 580)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County and Calvert Counties County -
Beer - Cash Sales

FOR the purpose of requiring manufacturers and wholesalers in Garrett County and Calvert counties County to sell beer to retailers for cash on delivery; prohibiting suits in contract to enforce or collect claims for credit extended on sales of beer from manufacturers and wholesalers to retailers in Garrett County and Calvert counties County; and generally relating to the sale of beer in Garrett County and Calvert counties County.
