

(C) A CATERER'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PROVIDE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT EVENTS THAT ARE HELD OFF THE CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE PREMISES.

(D) THE HOLDER SHALL PROVIDE FOOD AS WELL AS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION AT THE CATERED EVENT.

(E) A HOLDER MAY EXERCISE THE PRIVILEGES UNDER THIS LICENSE ONLY DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS THAT ARE PERMITTED IN THIS ARTICLE FOR A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY.

(F) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING CLASS B (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE TO HAVE A CATERER'S LICENSE FOR CATERING ON THE PREMISES THAT IS COVERED BY THE EXISTING LICENSE.

(g) (3) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO THE CONTRARY, IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, A CATERER'S ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

(House Bill 637)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Tax Refunds
