Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights - Investigatory Files

~~FOR the purpose of altering the current provisions of law that exclude the furnishing of confidential sources of information regarding a law enforcement officer under investigation to provide that such exclusion apply to information that is the subject of any other pending internal investigation and which is irrelevant to the investigation; FOR the purpose of requiring that a law enforcement officer under investigation be furnished with certain exculpatory information under certain circumstances; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to a requirement that a law enforcement officer under investigation be furnished with certain exculpatory information under certain circumstances.~~
